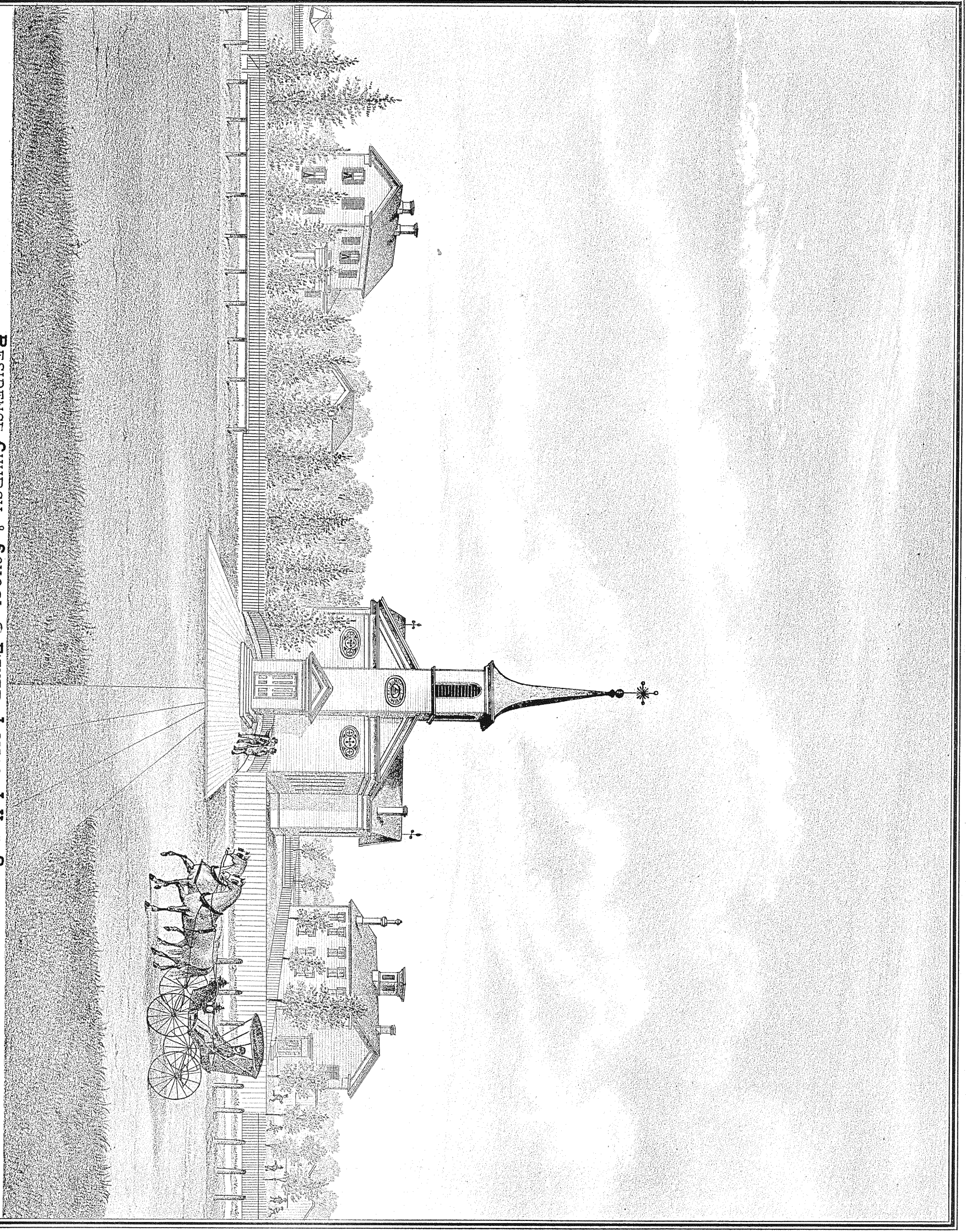

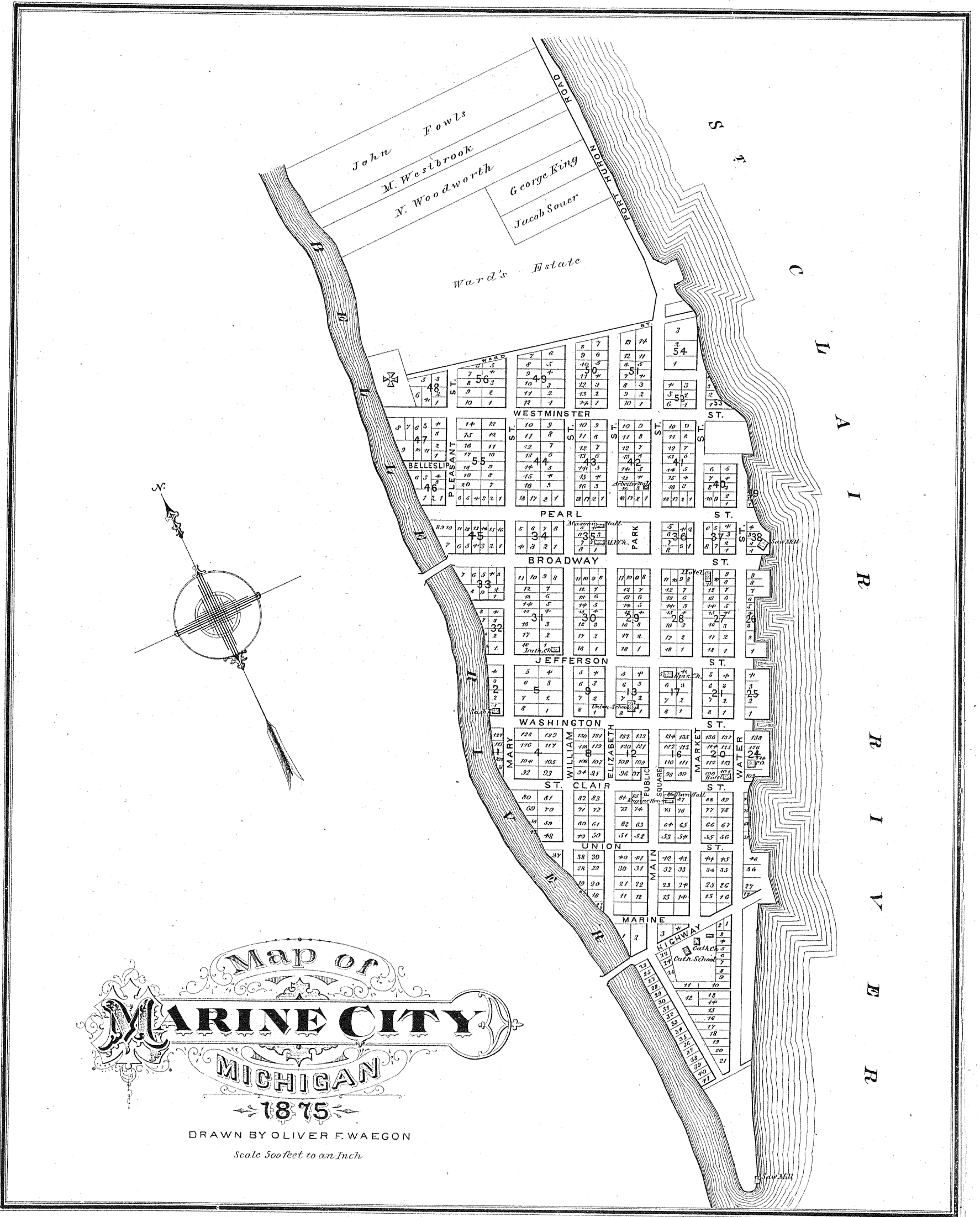

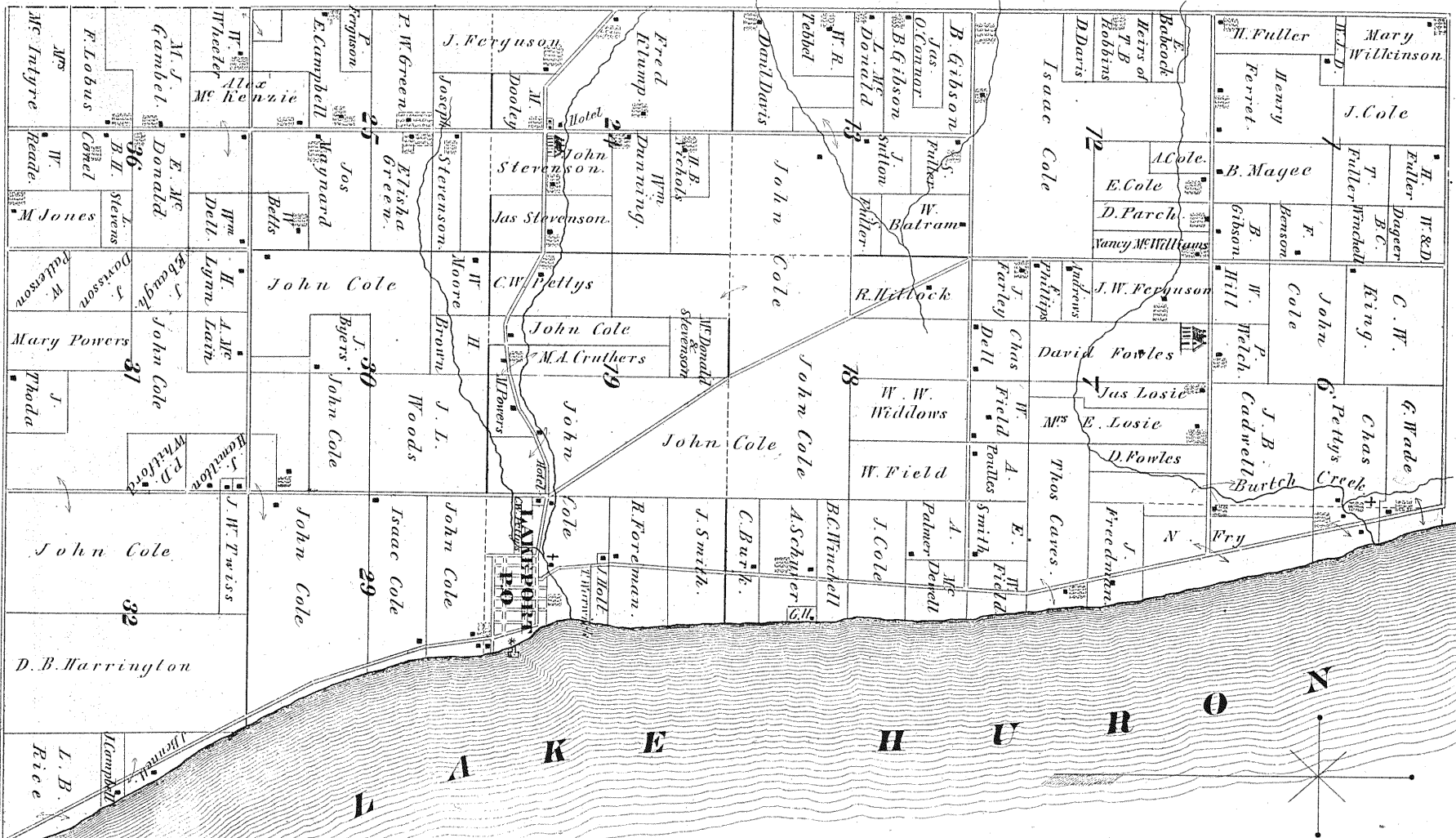

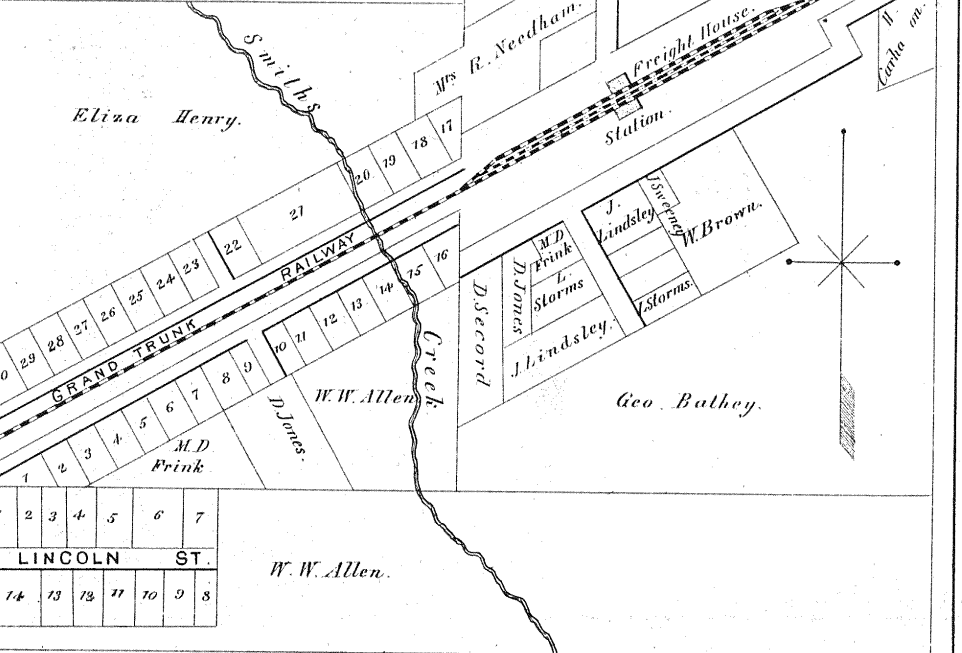
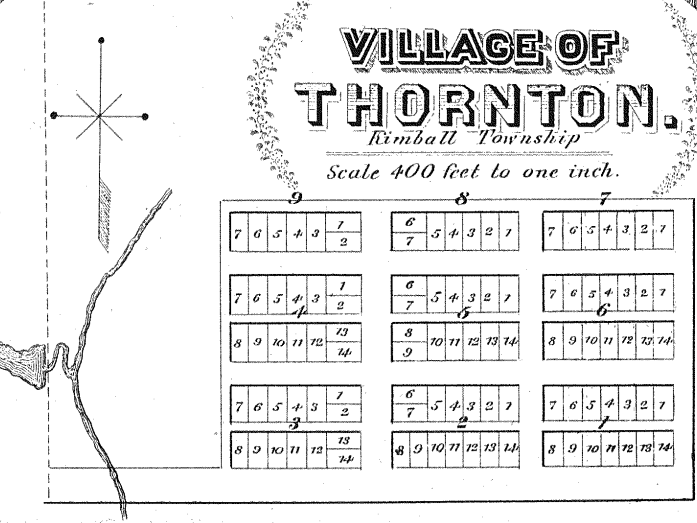
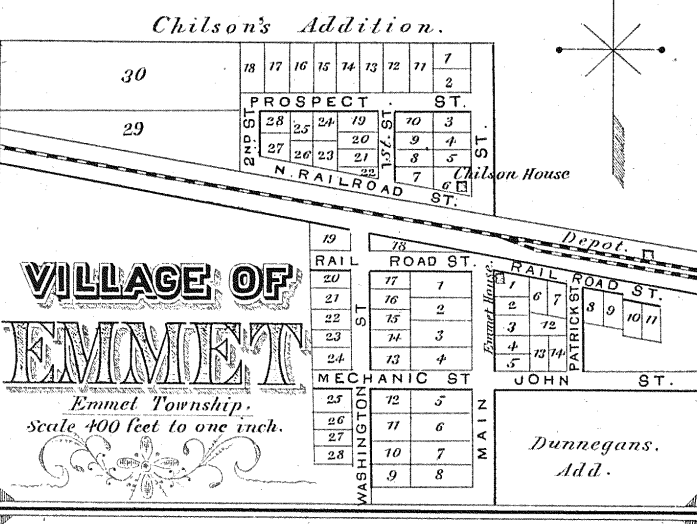
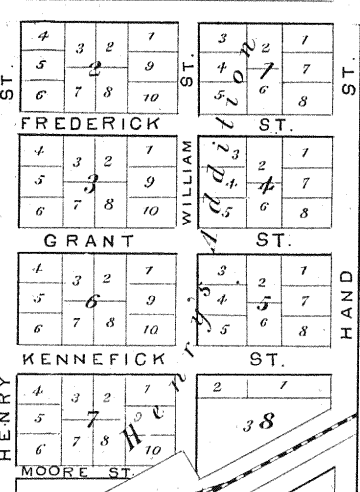
MAP OF BURTCHEVILLE TOWNSHIP
